Formed - Trustees Appointed

On motion of Supervisor Hart, seconded by Supervisor McFarland, it is ordered that the following resolution be, and the same is hereby adopted;

WHEREAS, there has been received by, and filed with the Board, the Petition of a majority of the electors enumerated upon the Great Register of this County, as residing within a district therein definitely described as hereinafter set forth, requesting that said district be organized as a public cemetery district, all pursuant to the provisions of an Act to provide for Public Cemetery Districts, approved March 6, 1909, as amended April 5, 1911, in which said Petition is set forth and designated by a majority of said electors, the names of the following electors residing within said district, to act as the Trustees of said District to act for the first term, to-wit: Four years, from Aug. 1, 1928, to August 1, 1932, and

WHEREAS, said Petition appears to conform in all respects to the provisions of Act,

IT IS ORDERED that a Public Cemetery District to be known and designated as "Public Cemetery District No. 1, of Kern County, California", be and the same is hereby created and organized, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that H. H. Jansen, Shafter Cal., H. 0. Walker, Wasco, Cal. and F. 0. Whalem, Shafter, Cal., be and they are hereby appointed Trustees of said Public Cemetery District No. 1, of Kern County, California, for a term of four years from August 1, 1928.
